



Non-Profit Agency Scholarship

Application Checklist

If you are a permanent employee of a non-profit agency in Washtenaw County you may apply for the Washtenaw Community College Non-Profit Agency Scholarship, which will provide payment for the tuition¹ of agency and WCC approved Economic, Community & College Development non-credit classes, applicable to your position at the agency.

You must complete all items on this checklist to successfully apply for the scholarship. Submit an application for each semester for each class you attend.

- Work for a non-profit agency in a permanent position within Washtenaw County and the class(es) requested must be applicable to your position at the agency.
- Submit the Non-Profit Agency Scholarship application (complete with supervisor approved class(es) and signature) 10 business days before start of class (**Note: *Online classes are not eligible for this scholarship***). Please Include the following:
 - A copy of your agency's 501(c)3 documentation
 - A job description of your current position within the non-profit agency
- You must attend all class sessions and complete all class requirements. ***If the class is not successfully completed, you or your agency may be billed for the full tuition and/or have your scholarship discontinued.***

Final approval of eligible classes is reserved by WCC. We will notify you of your application status within 10 business days after receipt.

Guidelines

If you are a permanent employee of a non-profit agency in Washtenaw County (permanent position) you may apply for the Washtenaw Community College Non-Profit Agency Scholarship, which will pay the tuition (only) of selected non-credit classes applicable to the student's position at the agency. Online classes are not eligible for this scholarship.

Please complete this application and submit, along with a copy of your agency's 501(c)3 documentation and a description of your current position, no later than 10 business days before the start of your first class. Once approved, this scholarship can be used for all agency approved classes for the approved semester.

NOTE: This application must be approved BEFORE registering for your class. This scholarship does not renew - a new application must be submitted for each semester you wish to apply.
