## JOINING A STUDY GROUP

Study groups can be a great way to practice and apply concepts you're learning in class. They can be particularly helpful when learning remotely as they create structure and routine for studying and provide opportunities for communication and collaboration! Here are the steps and best practices for joining one of our study groups:

- SIGN UP**  
Go to the WCC Gateway for Students to sign up for a study group. You'll click on the area to Schedule and Appointment, then on Learning Commons to get started. Study groups are organized by class section, so make sure you have those details handy!
- CHECK YOUR EMAIL**  
You'll receive an email at your WCC account with instructions for accessing the group - all groups are organized in Microsoft Teams.
- INTRODUCE YOURSELF**  
Once you're in the group, be sure to introduce yourself to your fellow group members. It is expected that all members will contribute to the group, so it's helpful to get to know one another.
- ASK & ANSWER**  
The chat feature in the group is designed to allow the group to communicate 24/7, so ask and answer questions when they come up and check the chat frequently. The study group's Peer Tutor will also oversee the chat and respond as necessary.
- ATTEND THE MEETINGS**  
Each study group has its own weekly meeting. These will be face-to-face web meetings through Teams and will be facilitated by a WCC Peer Tutor. Every group member should be prepared to participate. Frequent meeting absences may result in removal from the study group.
- BE RESPECTFUL**  
Remember that members of the study group may have different study habits, challenges and work at a different pace than you. Be courteous when chatting and participating in meetings by using appropriate and positive language.
- PRACTICE ACADEMIC HONESTY**  
Study groups are meant for collaboration, not for sharing answers. Study groups will be expected to adhere to the WCC Board policy on Academic Dishonesty as outlined in the Student Handbook.
