- B. With a *semicolon*

- C. With a *semicolon and a conjunctive adverb or a transitional phrase*

- D. By *subordinating* one of the clauses

English is easy, and we really love it.
English is easy, so we really love it.

B.
English is easy; we really love it.

C.
English is easy; therefore, we really love it.
English is easy; as a result, we really love it.
English is easy; in fact, we really love it.
English is easy; moreover, we really love it.

D.
Because English is easy, we really love it.
Since English is easy, we really love it.
We really love English because it is easy.
